NATIONAL CONFERENCE COMMITTEE (NCC) NEWS

Plans are already underway for the 2017 POC Conference in Toronto, ON from November 2-4, 2017 at the Westin Prince Hotel! As you're planning ahead and getting your 2017 calendars set up, block off the conference dates so you'll be available to come.



Save up for #POCConf2017

Now is the time to start saving for next year's conference. As you create your 2017 budget, plan to set aside enough money each month so you'll be able to attend! Here's an approximate breakdown:

Expense	Total Cost *	Monthly Amount to Save (Based on 10 months Jan-Oct)
Conference (based on 2016 rate)	\$565	\$57
Hotel (double occupancy for 3 nights based on current posted rates)	\$300	\$30

^{*}Note: all amounts are only estimates to help you budget. Actual amounts may be higher or lower.

If you set aside approximately \$87 per month from January to October, you could have enough to cover your conference expenses! Add on a bit more for meals and entertainment and you're all set.

Then, budget for your travel expenses. Here are some examples:

- For those traveling from the west, budget about \$70 per month (based on an average Vancouver to Toronto seat sale fare)
- From the east, save about \$50 per month (based on a Halifax to Toronto seat sale fare)
- From Montreal, set aside about \$15 per month (based on current Via prices)
- For those within driving distance from Toronto, you just need to factor in parking or public transportation costs.

When you break it down into a monthly savings plan, the cost of conference isn't as prohibitive as it seems when you have to pay for everything at once in August/September. For less than 1 organizing session per month you'll cover all your conference expenses!

And... if you apply just 1 thing you learned at conference this year, you'll probably earn more than enough extra to re-invest in conference next year! If you're not sure where to start, try applying a few things from Jane Veldhoven's session, "10 Tips For Making More Money".

If you didn't go to conference this year, check out the discussions, handouts, and slides for most of the sessions in the <u>Conference FB Group</u> to find something you can do to increase your business in 2017.

So, no excuses! Make your business and professional development a priority in 2017 by setting aside the time and money to be at your national conference!



POC reached 398,000 impressions for November 2016 and 12,869,608 for the year to date!




To be considered, ask yourself ...
