Call for Facilitators

Thank you to all the candidates who submitted Facilitator Applications.

TPO Exam

POC members who wish to write the POC TPO exam outside of a Chapter-hosted location must meet the following criteria:

- Applicant is currently a POC member.
- Applicant faces undue hardship writing the exam in the standard manner (an unreasonable driving distance to the hosted exam location, for example).
- It is the applicant's responsibility to find an invigilator to accept, administer, and return the exam. An invigilator may be:
 - a professional bound by a code of ethics (lawyer, notary public, minister, etc.);

- or a TPO in good standing for a minimum of 3 years and a current member of POC.
- The applicant is responsible for any costs incurred (exam room rental, travel costs, invigilator fees, etc.).
- Applicant must write the exam within the Spring/Summer POC exam time frame.
- The Director of Education will approve requests on a case-by-case basis.




