COMMITTEE NEWS

Ethics Committee Update

This fall an ethics complaint was received pertaining to a volunteer's term ending on a POC committee with concerns it was done prematurely and with premeditation. A Complaint Review Committee (CRC) was struck within the required timeline and in accordance with the Ethics Policy. The CRC determined the complaint had merit. The respondent was informed and given the opportunity to provide a response to the complaint. Subsequent investigation and thorough discussions resulted in a determination that the complaint was unsubstantiated. Both parties were informed, and again in accordance with the Policy, there was no appeal. A redacted report was provided to the Ethics Committee and the Board of Directors. The complaint is now closed.


