Trained Professional Organizer (TPO) Program

The Trained Professional Organizer Exam will be offered Thursday, November 7, 2019, at 10:15am prior to POC's 2019 National Conference, at the Radisson Admiral Hotel in Toronto. All exam candidates must <u>register</u> in advance.

Important reminder: Our online registration process requires completion of all required courses as confirmation of your eligibility to register for the exam. Those challenging the exam have other eligibility requirements.

Please ensure that you have completed your courses well in advance of the exam registration cutoff date, which is November 4, 2019 at midnight ET.

NOTE: This will be the last opportunity to write the exam in 2019. The next chance to write the exam will be in the spring of 2020.

NOTE: a minimum of 4 participants are required for this course to proceed. This course may not be offered again for some time, so if you want to take it, now is the time!


