Ethics Report

An Ethics Complaint Review Committee was formed in February to review a complaint alleging that the respondent deliberately attempted to discredit the complainant and harm her professional status and that the respondent knowingly created a situation that may have brought harm to individual members of the public and discredited POC, its members and the professional organizing profession. The ethics principles alleged to have been violated were:

- I will seek to deal with other POC members, professional colleagues, suppliers and employees in a fair and equitable manner, and maintain the highest standards of personal conduct to bring credit to the organizing profession.
- I will protect the public again fraud and unfair practices, and attempt to eliminate from POC all practices that bring discredit to the organizing profession.
- I will strive for excellence in all aspects of the organizing profession.

The committee did not find evidence that the respondent's postings were a deliberate attempt to harm or discredit either the complainant or members of the public. The committee determined that, nonetheless, there was potential for harm to the reputation of the complainant and to some members of the public. The committee also determined that the respondent exercised poor judgment and that the postings were unnecessary, unprofessional and a breach of the POC Code of Ethics as cited above.

The committee recommended the following:

- That the respondent either remove the postings in question or edit the postings to remove any reference to the complainant or the complainant's activities;
- That the respondent review the POC Code of Ethics:
- That the respondent refrain from any future remarks on social media that may be seen to discredit another POC member or member of the public;
- That if any other communications of this type are brought to the Ethics Committee, further action will be taken;
- That both parties refrain from communicating with each other in any way on social media;
 and
- That both parties attempt to move forward from this point on.

The complaint was closed on April 10, 2016.


CHAPTER NEWS


