2020-21 Term report...

- Open communication was encouraged with adding anonymous Google Form questionnaires to each monthly Chapter Chat.
- All eleven Chapter meetings made available to all members each month, regardless
 of what Chapter they belong to opening up a vast increase in education & virtual
 networking possibilities.
- Closed Facebook Group communication amongst POC National, Chapters and Members increased, since in-person meeting was halted.
- The North GTA Chapter was dissolved due to lack of volunteers for its Executive.
- The Grand River Chapter had also been put on hiatus and recently dissolved due to lack of volunteers for its Executive.
- The Ottawa Chapter was put on hiatus due to lack of volunteers for its Executive.
- The new monthly celebratory Member Anniversary Announcement was introduced and continues to be maintained.
- A digital version of POC NOWeek (National Organizing Week) was brought back in May 2021, with social media posts being encouraged.
- The Chapter Zoom policy was updated to include increased numbers (being released in October 2021)
- Updated the Social Media logos, which will be rolling out within October 2021.
