### **DID YOU KNOW?**

Professional Organizers who have obtained Silver Leaf Member status, have been members in good standing of POC for at least ten consecutive years, and who have accumulated 100 service points are eligible for Gold Leaf Member status. Being part of a National POC committee such as the Ethics Committee allows you to collect 10 points per year of service.

#### **FOOD FOR THOUGHT**

Before and after photos are often a great way to attract views on social media platforms, inspire our followers to declutter and organize their own space themselves while showing potential clients what we could do for them.

However, not all clients are comfortable with their "before" or even their "after"

photos finding their way onto the Internet. Do you have a standard operating procedure set up to obtain your clients' consent? Some organizers include it in their contracts, others have a separate consent form.

Furthermore, some professionals in our industry not only ensure they have the client's consent to take photos but then also ask for approval before publishing them. What is your practice?

Confidentiality should always be top of mind.

What should you ensure before you take any photos, in order to protect your client's confidentiality?

Are there personal photographs displayed in the space you are photographing and if so, did you remove them before taking your photo? Can you see any diplomas or pieces of art that could unintentionally divulge your client's identity? Are there any other visible clues that could allow someone to find out in whose house the photos were taken?

For how long do you have the right to share these photos? Do you address this in your contract or anywhere else?

There are many factors to consider when we choose to use before and after photos in our marketing activities. Why not have a discussion within your chapter to share best practices once monthly meetings start again in September?

The Facebook page saw excellent engagement in July, 5.8%, and a notable boost in comments. Facebook posts got users talking, with lots of positive, relevant comments. There were 2,424 likes, an increase of 9 from last month, and a reach of 6,375.

The Twitter audience had a slight increase and the engagement rate is steady. There were 2,249 followers and 4,587 impressions.


### **Pinterest**
