Members who carry business insurance and have sent in their certificate of liability insurance to our Membership Coordinator have the icon next to their name in the POC directory to inform prospective clients of their adherence.

Business insurance not only has the undeniable advantage of protecting our business from risk, but also demonstrates to our customers that our business is credible and reliable.

Please remember that it is up to each member to send in the supporting documentation demonstrating annual renewal of coverage to keep the "i" icon next to their name in the directory. When the information is not sent in prior to the expiration date, the "i" is removed.

# **POC's Social Media Pages**




